A young and upcoming rider on the GNCC and OMA national scene is Team Pro Moto Billet/Fastway Performance rider Adam Bonneur. We asked Adam a few questions about himself and his racing season so far this year.

PMB: Tell us a little about yourself and your racing career. How did you get started racing?

Adam: Well I've lived in Morrison on a farm all my life. So it all started with my dad's farm quad and after I trashed it at the age of 5 he decided that I needed something different. For my 6th birthday, I had my very first motorcycle.

PMB: What is the coolest thing about racing dirt bikes?

Adam: The thing I like most is the people you get to meet and the places you get to see. Not many people get to do the things we get to do every weekend or so.

I'm also fortunate enough to enjoy the sport with my family. My parents are very supportive and I wouldn't be where I am today without them.

PMB: What is something people likely don't know about you?

Adam: I absolutely love music, it's a big part of my life. I think if I weren't so involved with racing, I'd do anything to be in a band.



PMB: What are you most proud of?

Adam: Last year, I put together a decent season in the OMA's, despite injury. I have two 4th places and two 5th places. It's a tough job to ride with the boys that do it for a living, and to have 4 top 5 finishes is an accomplishment.

PMB: Tell us about your coolest road trip experience.

Adam: Well, the OMA series has been around for about 10 years and round 8 takes place in northern Iowa, and when I was in the 80 class, we camped at the local campground and there was a massive pool with a huge waterslide, the works. All my racing buddies and my entire family camped from Thursday through Monday. It was an experience I'll never forget.
